Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (**PBIS**) is a school wide approach that...

- Focuses on building a safe and positive learning environment for all students
- Creates universal behavioral expectations at all FASD schools
- Involves the direct teaching and reteaching of expectations
- Celebrates the achievements of students, classrooms, and staff
- Monitors and addresses behavioral concerns
- Helps students achieve personal growth

PBIS ACTIVITIES AT FAMS

Activities, recognition, and incentives for following the **FAMS WAY** are always changing, but the goal is the same:

build community and **teach expectations!**

- Home Room Challenges
 - Trivia, Tug of War, Track & Field, Team Building, Hot Shots
- School Wide
 - Politeness Police, Assemblies, Character Lessons
- Rewards



DISCIPLINE WITHIN PBIS

While consequences are assigned to address certain behavioral concerns, we understand that *these consequences alone rarely change student behavior.*

PBIS focuses on prevention of behavior through the direct teaching, reteaching, prompting, and acknowledging of positive and expected behaviors.
